BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Township of Boonton, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, on August 10, 2026 and the twenty (20) day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office in the Municipal Building in said Township for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title:	Bond ordinance providing for the acquisition of vehicular equipment by the Township of Boonton, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, appropriating \$130,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$120,000 bonds or notes of the Township for financing such appropriation
Purpose(s):	Acquisition by purchase of new and additional vehicular equipment for use by the Fire Department of the Township, including one (1) pickup truck, together with all attachments, appurtenances and accessories necessary therefor or incidental thereto.
Appropriation:	\$130,000
Bonds/Notes Authorized:	\$120,000
Grants (if any) Appropriated:	\$0
Section 20 Costs:	\$5,000
Useful Life:	5 years
