NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the governing body of the Township of Boonton, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, on July 13, 2026. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building in said Township on August 10, 2026 at 7:00 o'clock P.M. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office in said Municipal Building for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title:	Bond ordinance providing for the acquisition of vehicular equipment by the Township of Boonton, in the County of Morris, New Jersey, appropriating \$130,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$120,000 bonds or notes of the Township for financing such appropriation
Purpose(s):	Acquisition by purchase of new and additional vehicular equipment for use by the Fire Department of the Township, including one (1) pickup truck, together with all attachments, appurtenances and accessories necessary therefor or incidental thereto.
Appropriation:	\$130,000
Bonds/Notes Authorized:	\$120,000
Grants (if any) Appropriated:	\$0
Section 20 Costs:	\$5,000
Useful Life:	5 years
