#### VIRTUAL CLASSES: MONDAY

**VIRTUAL: Storybook Writing:** 2<sup>nd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> w/ Ms. Martino Our virtual creative writing class will use the program StoryJumper ([www.storyjumper.com](http://www.storyjumper.com)). Each student will use their own personal account to write, illustrate, and publish their own creative stories. The program allows students to collaborate with a friend to create together, or students can write on their own. At the end of the class, you can even purchase a hardcover, paperback, or digital eBook of your child's story. Time to let the creative juices flow and bring the fun back into writing! 8 weeks of classes!

**VIRTUAL: Little Vet School:** K-6<sup>th</sup> w/ Nix at Little Medical School, LLC. In our Little Veterinarian School, students will role-play the key responsibilities of a veterinarian and learn about providing the best dog care. These future veterinarians will learn about cleaning their dog's ears, performing a nose to tail exam, how dog food is made, how dogs use their tails, learn about careers in veterinarian medicine, and more! We will begin the program with a White Coat Ceremony and conclude with a Graduation Ceremony. Products include a disposable white coat, a plush dog, modeling dough, an LMS dictionary, and other materials for our 8-week program! Remember to have paper, pencils, crayons, or markers handy.

**VIRTUAL: Become a Game Designer with Scratch MIT (Level 1)** 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> for 6 weeks (Dates: 1/25, 2/01, 2/08, 2/15, 2/22, 3/01 – this class will run during February Break) w/ Built By Me! Learn how to code and create simple games using Scratch MIT, a block-based coding developed by MIT. Each session our instructor will guide the participants to build a new and different game or program. Students will learn about various game mechanics; create games in Scratch MIT and develop computational thinking. **Notes:** To take part in the program virtually, you must have access to a **laptop or Chromebook with a webcam as well as an Internet connection with access to Zoom and Scratch MIT**. Headphones and microphone recommended.

#### VIRTUAL CLASSES: TUESDAY

**VIRTUAL: Trivia Time:** 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> w/ Mrs. Snider Children will test their knowledge in a variety of subjects like math, logic puzzles, and pop-culture. The kids will play games such as Jeopardy, Wheel of Fortune, and BINGO! A small whiteboard, marker, and eraser will be needed for some of the activities. 8 weeks of classes!

**VIRTUAL: Comic Book Writing:** 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> w/ GC Lear of Unlimited Wonder Comics Lab. Participants will be introduced to the medium of comics as a way of sharing their own stories. Each week they will be participating in drawing and comic making activities as well as learning about influential cartoonists and their work. There will be interactive and collaborative storytelling activities using the free Google Jamboard application. **Suggested Materials:** blank 3x5 cards, black pen (Uniball Vision black Fine pen is inexpensive at staples/office supply store), colored pencils, standard white letter/copy paper, scotch tape, scissors.

#### VIRTUAL CLASSES: WEDNESDAY

**VIRTUAL: Lego Creations:** K-2nd w/ Mrs. Ennis. Students will have a blast using Legos to make fun creations and complete exciting challenges. Try your best to build the mystery objects from each week's theme while watching some fun LEGO shows and movies! (Bring your own LEGOs!)

**VIRTUAL: Escape Room:** 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> w/ Mrs. Snider. Will your team escape in time? Try this escape room style game with a team of peers while using logic and math skills. Sign up with your friends and have a fun afternoon! A different room will need to be escaped each week!

**VIRTUAL: Techno FUNK:** 3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> w/ Mrs. Covart. Do you love listening to music? If yes, why not try making some of your own. Have fun and make some music with websites such as Noteflight, Soundation, and Google based websites. We'll start

with easy composing and move onto more complex websites, but all at your level. No prior experience or note reading required. Let's rock!

**VIRTUAL: CodeMaker: with Brain Bytes Academy** 1<sup>st</sup> -5<sup>th</sup> Coding for ALL! Whether you are a beginner or have coded with us before, this class is for you! Calling all aspiring innovators! Dive into programming logic with block coding, the drag-and-drop creative learning environment. You will use code blocks and characters to gain a foundation in computational thinking, creating animated stories and games. Bright visuals and engaging design enhance the learning process, making it easy for you to develop essential STEM skills for our tech-driven world. 8 weeks of classes!

#### **VIRTUAL CLASSES: THURSDAY**

**VIRTUAL: ROBLOX:** 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> w/Mrs. Johnson. ROBLOX is an interactive web-based game where students can either play pre-developed games or they can develop their own game and others can play within the game that they developed. Children will need to use their RVS account to log into the game with Mrs. Johnson and the class will meet over Google Meet. 8 weeks of classes!

#### **VIRTUAL CLASSES: FRIDAY**

**VIRTUAL: Fantasy Book Club:** 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> w/ Mrs. Link Welcome to the new Fantasy Book Club! Books to read will be selected as a group so everyone's interests are filled! Book talks are a great way to keep the story going, and this book club is sure to be FUN! 8 weeks of classes!

**VIRTUAL: Chess Club:** K-8<sup>th</sup> w/ Chess Wizards for all grades and all skill levels! Not sure what level you are or never played a game of chess in your life? Before class begins, students will be asked to take a Chess Skill Level **PLACEMENT TEST** to determine skill levels. All skill levels will run at the same date and time, except in different zooms with different instructors. Classes will focus on concepts, puzzles, game play, with instructor review and fun activities for kids to learn the game of chess!

**VIRTUAL: Junior Film Director:** 2<sup>nd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> for 6 weeks (Dates: 1/29, 2/05, 2/12, 2/19, 2/26, 3/05 – this will run during February Break) **Built By Me** will introduce students to the art and technique of filmmaking using stop-motion techniques. The young directors will go through the steps required to make a short stop motion movie, including writing a script, drawing a storyboard, developing characters, making puppets or using Lego®, shooting scenes, editing, and adding sound effects. **Notes:** To take part in the program virtually you must have a **Tablet (Ipad, Droid, or Amazon Fire) with Stop Motion Pro app installed. Laptop or Chromebook with a webcam as well as an Internet connection with access to Zoom.** Headphones and microphone recommended.

**VIRTUAL: PESA's All Sports Camp** This class will help kids get up and moving. Each week the class will focus on either soccer or basketball – kids should have these balls at home and a hoop for basketball practice. Students will be taught the importance of exercising and how to take care of their body all while having fun! Half hour classes will get them MOVING!

**IN PERSON CLASSES – Please follow state issued COVID-19 protocol - Check temperature before coming to class. If exhibiting any symptoms, please stay home. Bring your own water bottle & equipment. Must arrive wearing a mask until students are socially distanced.**

**IN PERSON: Jazz and Hippy Hop:** K-3<sup>rd</sup> w/ Miss Katherine of Dancers Pointe. Your child will learn a stylized and refined form of sassy street dancing with a jazz flair. Miss Katherine will teach the fundamental aspects of jazz dance while adding some hip-hop technique. The dancers improve their flexibility, balance, and coordination. Jazz/hip hop improves their strength and overall dance technique. This is an energetic and fun class that will surely be a very exciting part of your child's day. It will be held at Miss Katherine's studio, Dancers Pointe: 710 Myrtle Ave, Suite A, Boonton, NJ – shared parking lot with Boonton Lanes. 8 weeks of classes!
